


# Zone Banner Specifications for 2020 LWML District Convention

2020 LWML Oklahoma District Convention colors are **Purple (Orchid), Lime Green, Silver**

1. Finished banner size is to be 2' X 3' using the convention logo and convention colors specified (see above). Added fringe may be longer. Do not use the convention logo but a design that brings out the theme Bible verse.
2. Heavy fabric or bulky items are discouraged, as your banner should be relatively easy to manage when carried.
3. The name of your zone should be on the bottom of the banner.
4. Attach two ties to the back of the banner lining. One of the ties is to be at the center of the banner width, about 10-12 inches from the top. The second tie is to be at the center of the banner width about 10-12 inches from the bottom. These ties should be long enough to tie a bow around a 2" pole, and are necessary to help hold the banner to the pole. Note: Do **not** use Velcro to hold banner to pole, as it has proved to be ineffective. Please use ties as described.
5. Dowels used at the bottom of banners help to keep it hanging straight when carried and hanging. They must be tacked in place to prevent them from slipping out of the casing.
6. Attach the banner to a 3/4" dowel with a screw eye on each end of the dowel. **Please use a strong quarter-inch or 8 mm cord.** Make a small loop at the center for hanging. Secure the cord through each eye screw, laying the cord flat along the dowel, with the small loop at the center of the banner. Knot the cord on the outside of each screw. Be sure to attach the cord tightly because it will stretch when the banner is hung. We encourage you to hang your banner before sending it to the convention, to allow time for stretching.
7. Please supply a banner pole for procession and to display the banner at the convention.
